QUICK FACTS

- Worldwide 500 people die from drug abuse every day—over 200,000 per year.
- 70% of all crime worldwide is drug related.
- Almost 1 million dollars is generated in illegal drug sales every 25 seconds.
- 210 million people internationally consume illegal drugs – this is more than the populations of California, New York and the countries of Spain, the United Kingdom and Australia combined.
- The illegal drug trade is estimated at \$322 billion a year. This is more than the Gross National Product of 88% of the world's nations.
- There are an estimated 3.6 million cocaine addicts in the U.S. alone.
